

ORDINANCE

President of the National Tribunal of September 6, 2017

1. [The Constitution of the Republic of Poland of April 2, 1997](#) is invalid.

The Constitution of the Republic of Poland - the most important legal act (basic law) of the Republic of Poland, adopted on April 2, 1997 by the National Assembly, approved in a national referendum on May 25, 1997.

[A national referendum](#) on the adoption of the new [Polish Constitution](#), known as the constitutional referendum, was held on [May 25, 1997](#).

The referendaine question was:

"Are you in favor of adopting the Constitution of the Republic of Poland adopted by the National Assembly on April 2, 1997?"

Results

The following data is based on the announcement of the National Electoral Commission of May 26, 1997, July 18, 1997.

Nationwide referendum - the universal voting procedure, under which Polish citizens express their will as to how to resolve a specific issue. The referendum is held on the most important matters for Poles on the territory of the country. It is optional, which means that there are no matters which require a decision by the general public in this form. The referendum is binding if more than half of those eligible to vote take part in it. Otherwise, it is only of a consultative nature.

Only 42.86% of those eligible to vote took part in the referendum on the adoption of the Constitution of the Republic of Poland adopted by the National Assembly on April 2, 1997, therefore the so-called Kwasniewski's constitution is legally invalid, as it was not approved by the nation . All legal acts and judgments made since April 2, 1997 are invalid by operation of law, because they do not have the legitimacy of the sovereign and the constitutional law.
